

Privacy Statement

1. Who we are

Rosa Danza Studio (RDS), Nosticova 465/2, 118 00 Malá Strana, Praha, Czech Republic, is responsible for collecting and processing your personal data.

2. What data we collect

We collect only the personal data necessary to provide our services, including:

- Name and contact details (email address, phone number)
- Registration details for courses, workshops, and events
- Emergency contact information (if applicable)
- Communication records (emails and messages)
- Newsletter subscription details (if you choose to subscribe)
- Website form submissions (such as enrollment forms submitted via our website)
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If children participate in our programs, their data is provided by a parent or legal guardian.

3. How we use your data

We use your personal data only for the following purposes:

- Managing registrations for classes, workshops, and events
- Organizing and providing our services
- Communicating important information related to your participation
- Responding to inquiries and messages
- Sending newsletters (only if you have given consent)
- Administrative and organizational purposes
- Meeting legal obligations (such as accounting and taxation)

4. Where your data is stored

Your personal data is stored securely in:

- Our WordPress website system, which stores enrollment form submissions for a limited period of time
- Our internal communication systems (such as email)
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Access to this data is limited to authorized persons within RDS.

5. Sharing your data

We do not sell or use your personal data for marketing by third parties.

Your personal data is only shared or accessed when necessary:

- With our accountant, for bookkeeping and tax purposes
- Within our WordPress website system and hosting environment, where enrollment data is processed and stored
- With public authorities, if required by law
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We ensure that all data is handled securely and only for the purposes stated above.

6. Legal basis for processing

We process personal data based on:

- Performance of a contract (providing classes and services)
- Your consent (for example, newsletters and optional communications)
- Legal obligations (such as accounting requirements)
- Our legitimate interest in operating and improving our services

7. Data retention

We keep personal data only for as long as necessary to:

- Provide our services
- Fulfill legal obligations
- Maintain necessary administrative records

You may request deletion of your data where legally possible.

8. Cookies and website use

Our website may use cookies to ensure basic functionality and improve user experience. You can disable cookies in your browser settings, but some features of the website may not function properly.

9. Your rights

You have the right to:

- Access your personal data
- Correct inaccurate data
- Request deletion of your data (where legally possible)
- Restrict or object to processing
- Withdraw consent at any time (e.g. newsletter subscription)
